Issues Online is a great place to click-start your research and studies with resources that focus on current social issues, PSHE-related topics and a whole range of subjects. To access the ebooks you may need to log in to Issues Online as a Lewisham College student even if you have already logged into eME.

Select an E-Book by clicking on the cover or title. Scroll down for more E-Books to chose from.


Open an E-Book

Above the front cover will be a tool bar.

Use the tools on the tool bar to:

- change the page view (2 pages or 1 page)
- change the scale of the pages
- change fullscreen
- select the page to view
- perform a search within the E-Book.



Click here to move forwards through each E-Book page or directly to the back cover.
